
# Up2You Newsletter #1: memories of Cyprus and new skills to improve ourselves

The goal? To co-design the **Community Balance Scorecard (CBS)**—a groundbreaking tool for measuring and enhancing community welfare and development.




## What is the Community Balance Scorecard (CBS)?

The CBS is an innovative framework designed to monitor and evaluate key aspects of community welfare, such as environmental sustainability, education, social cohesion, and economic growth. Think of it as a tailored report card that helps communities identify strengths, address challenges, and align their efforts with the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
